WHAT ARE THE DIFFERENT NAMES FOR THE DEVIL???

In the English BIBLE, we see that the enemy has about 28 different names. In order for you to understand who you are fighting against, you need to know each of those 28 names. Here are the Scripture references for each 1, so you can check it out, if interested.

- 1) The devil (Mat.4:1 & Rev.20:2) He resists God.
- 2) The accuser- He accuses God's people day & nite before God (Re12:10).
- 3) Abaddon (Rev.9:11). Hebrew word for Destroyer.
- 4) Satan (1Chr.21:1, Job 1:6, Jn.13:27, Lu.10:18, Lu.22:3, Ac.5:3).
- 5) Lucifer (Is.14:12). It means light-bearer.
- 6) The adversary (1 Pe.5:8) the enemy of God, not the opposite of God.
- 7) The tempter (Mat.4:3 & 1Thess.3:5).
- 8) The murderer (Jn.8:44) a murderer from the beginning, Jesus said.
- 9) The liar (Jn.8:44), there is no truth in him, Jesus said.
- 10) The father of lies (Jn.8:44), the originator of lies.
- 11) The roaring lion (1 Pe.5:8), seeking whom he may devour.
- 12) The serpent (Gen.3:1, 2 Cor.11:3, Rev.12:9 & Rev.20:2).
- 13) The angel of light (2 Cor.11:13-15). (Maybe Maroni w/Joseph Smith)
- 14) The god of this age (2 Cor.4:4), the god of many people today.
- 15) Apollyon (Rev.9:11). Greek word for Destroyer.
- 16) The angel of the bottomless pit (Rev.9:11).
- 17) Beelzebub (Mat.12:24 & Lu.11:15). The lord of the flies.
- 18) Belial (2 Cor.6:15). Means: the perverted/ the worthless.
- 19) The dragon (Rev.12:3 & 20:2). (might have started w/legs & lost them)
- 20) The enemy (Mat.13:39).
- 21) The lying spirit (1 Ki.22:22).
- 22) The power of darkness (Col.1:13).
- 23) The ruler of this world (Jn.12:31, 14:30, 16:11) mentioned 3 X by Jesus
- 24) The prince of the power of the air (Eph.2:2).
- 25) The ruler of demons (Mat.12:24).
- 26) The spirit that works in the children of disobedience (Eph.2:2).
- 27) The unclean spirit (Mat.12:43).
- 28) The wicked one (Mat.13:19).

HOW DOES SATAN WORK AGAINST US???

There are about 22 schemes constantly used by the devil, to work against us. Today, we see 6 of them:

- **S#1)** Misrepresentation "Don't trust in Egypt", it's a broken strength. **TOOL:** TRUTH. It's not Egypt that I am trusting in.
- S#2) Slander "Don't trust in the Lord your God, His altars were taken down".

 TOOL: ACCURATE FACTS. They were not God's altars.
- **S#3)** <u>Seduction</u> He seduces w/promises of material rewards, usually lies. **TOOL: COMMON SENSE.** Nobody promises anything to his enemies.
- **S#4)** False claims He swears he is of God. All his claims are total lies. **TOOL:** DENIAL. Deny his claims. Do not get into a debate.
- S#5) Outright Lies "We came from a far country".

 TOOL: REJECTION. Reject those lies.
- **S#6)** <u>Deception</u> using dirty tricks, moldy bread, old wineskins, or sandals. **TOOL: WISDOM.** Ask God to see beyond the facts, beyond the scheme.
